

SARAECE ABSTRACT INFORMATION FOR NATIONAL CONFERENCE $\underline{10^{th}\text{-}}11^{th}$ $\underline{\text{May 2018}}$

The SARAECE scientific committee welcomes both abstracts for paper presentations and poster presentations.

1. Poster presentations

The poster presentation could include a mix of text and graphics and it will also provide an opportunity for dialogue with the author. Selected posters will be displayed around the venue and a dedicated time will be allocated for poster presentation and dialogue with the respective authors.

Individual paper/s

a. Individual paper presentation will include a short presentation of 20 minutes plus an additional 10 minutes for questions and responses. Individual papers will be grouped according to the themes of the conference which will be selected by the SARAECE's scientific committee.

The two types of presentations must correspond with the themes of the conference. When submitting your abstracts please include the following:

- 1. The title of the presentation
- 2. The type of the presentation
- 3. The name/s, institution/s and email address/es of the presenters and co-author/s for (multi-authored papers, please indicate which authors will be presenting)
- 4. Mailing address and e-mail address
- 5. A 250 word abstract addressing each element specified on the submission form:
 - Research aims

- Relationship to previous works-referenced to existing literature and how it underpins your study
- Theoretical and conceptual framework
- Paradigm and methodology
- Ethical considerations
- Main finding or discussion
- Implications for practice or policy in regard to 'transforming teacher education in the early years'.
- 6. Five keywords
- 7. All abstracts to be in '12' Times New Roman font with double line spacing.
- 8. All abstracts to be submitted in word format as an attachment and sent via email to anya.morris@ccdi.org.za
- 9. Closing date for abstract submission: 31st March 2018
- 10. Closing date for registration: 30th April 2018
