Minimum Requirements

An appropriate formal education qualification for Grade R, Foundation Phase and / or Intermediate Phase teaching.

In addition, the position requires the following:

- Minimum 3 years RECENT (within the last 5 years) teaching experience in Grade R / the Foundation Phase / Intermediate Phase.
- Appropriate experience in mentoring and assessing student teachers at school level.
- Currently an unemployed or retired teacher, member of school management team or district official.
- Fully computer literate and proficient in English.
- Access to sufficient reliable Wi-Fi data and a functional laptop or desktop.
- Valid driving license and own reliable transport.
- Willingness to travel reasonable distances within and / or outside own province and occasionally stay overnight at employer expense.
- Competent and confident to engage effectively as mentor and assessor with student-teachers at schools.

Required Competencies (Skills, Knowledge and Behavioural Attributes)

- Knowledge of the South African education system and national curriculum regarding Grade R, BEd Foundation Phase / BEd Intermediate Phase education.

- High level of computer literacy.
- Appropriate language and communication skills including report writing.
- Ability to work as part of a team; under pressure; meet deadlines as well as work independently.
